School Prayer Space. We are hosting a Prayer Space for the pupils of Dunclug Primary School from this Tuesday (23rd) to Thursday (25th) in Ballyloughan. Prayer Spaces in Schools is an initiative of the organisation 24/7 Prayer, and Scripture Union NI and their Schools' Workers have been running Prayer Spaces in schools across Northern Ireland this year. A Prayer Space is for children of all faiths or none to come and be still, explore life's questions, process their worries, express things they are thankful for and pray, if they would like to. We aim to demonstrate to them that we can pray in any way, at any time, and God will always hear us. Eve McMullan (SU Ballymena School worker) is taking the lead on this but we're looking for volunteers from the local churches to help supervise a prayer space activity each day for as long or short a time as you can.
