777 Week of Prayer

Sunday: '<u>Hearts Returning</u>' – praying for the Lord to ignite our passion for Him

PONDER

Revelation 2: 1-7

'To the angel of the church in Ephesus write:

These are the words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand and walks among the seven golden lampstands. ²I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance. I know that you cannot tolerate wicked people, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false. ³You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary.

⁴Yet I hold this against you: you have forsaken the love you had at first. ⁵ Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place. ⁶ But you have this in your favour: you hate the practices of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

⁷Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.

PRAY

- Give thanks for the calling, freedom, and privilege we have as individuals, and as a body together, to enter the Most Holy Place.
- Give thanks for the huge team of people that contribute in some way to our Sunday worship: from welcome teams, to media teams, musicians and singers, leaders, preachers...
- Pray that all involved in preparing and leading our services would be dependent on the Spirit of God - that we wouldn't depend on our ability but on Him.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would so work in all our lives, so that we're loving the Lord not just with our mind and strength, but also our heart and soul ("love the Lord Your God with all your patience and prayer and intelligence and energy" Peterson).
- Pray that there would be a wonderful sense in our worship that "the Lord is here" that the already-present Holy Spirit would fill and more fully overtake our hearts
 giving us a fresh awareness of the Lord's holiness and grace.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would turn our singing into adoration, our theology into doxology, our listening into living and loving.
- Pray for those whose hearts have grown cold, losing the love for the Lord they had
 at first, in many cases displacing their love for the Lord with other loves. Pray that
 the Lord would lead them to repentance.
- Pray that as we gather for worship, we wouldn't gather as selfish consumers looking to be pleased, but as true worshipers, longing to be consumed with God's glory and grace.
- Pray that Jesus would become greater in our lives, and other things would "grow strangely dim in the light of his glory and grace." Why not use the song 'Turn your eyes upon Jesus' as a prayer of response.
